The Government of the Republic of Liberia through the Ministry of Agriculture PSIP-2025 has received budgetary allotments for the fiscal year 2025 and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward the Procurement of Rehabilitation of County Offices.

The Ministry of Agriculture now invites sealed bids from eligible registered businesses in the service of Construction to participate in the Construction/Rehabilitation of MOA County Offices. Additionally, bidder who is applying must have complied with the vendor registration process & procedure by the Public Procurement & Concessions Commission and are on the website of the commission and E-Mansion.

Bidding will be conducted using the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) process and procedure as enshrined in the Public Procurement and Concession Act (PPCA) of September 2010.

OUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- i. up to date tax clearance certificate;
- ii. valid business registration certificate; F4100
- iii. submit copy of the Public Procurement & Concessions Commission (PPCC) vendor completed registration form;
- iv. past performance history with at least three (3) references with contract numbers
- v. availability of supplies at all time
- vi. Guarantee schedule of delivery
- vii. Minimum one-year warranty on products to be supplied.
- viii. Ability to pre-finance supplies based upon an approved local purchase order by the Ministry of Finance & Development Planning

All interested and eligible bidders may obtain copy of the bid documents from the Procurement Unit of the Ministry of Agriculture for a nonrefundable fee of US \$150.00 beginning Wednesday, Thursday 13, 2025 – Friday, March 13, 2025 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday to Friday daily.

All bids must be accompanied with a **Bids Security Declaration** as indicated in the bidding document in Section IV bidding forms.

Sealed bids must be delivered to the Procurement Unit no later than 11:00 am 13th March 2025. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidder who choose to attend or their representatives on 13th March 2025 at 11:00 am on the 2nd floor in the conference room of the Ministry of Agriculture (MOA).
