PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

Purchase of 120 (One Hundred Twenty) Units of Rough Terrain Motorcycles for Laboratory Services, Surveillance and Response for used by the National Public Health Institute of Liberia and the Ministry of Agriculture for the COVID-19 Response.

In pursuant to the Procurement Guidelines under IBRD and IDA Credits (2016) revised November 2017 and August 2018– Section VI (6.12) on World Bank Procedures for Request for Quotation (RFQ) Process, the Ministry of Health through the Liberia COVID-19 Emergency Response Project (LCER) wish to inform the general public especially the

bidders of the outcomes of the bidding process for purchase of 120 (One Hundred Twenty) Off Road Motorcycles for laboratory services, Surveillance and Response for COVID-19 emergency which was sourced from the only two known suppliers of said motorbikes; each of the two (2) suppliers responded that they do have available limited quantity of the motorbikes in stock: CICA Motors Liberia Inc. confirmed having forty six (46) units, while MASARCO Auto Services confirmed having in stock seventy four (74) units. Because of the emergency nature and these are the only two suppliers trading in this specified rough terrain motorbikes, purchase order contracts were issued to each of the two (2) suppliers to supply the total sum of the 120 available motorbikes in stock, especially at the same rate previously purchase from each of the suppliers.

The process for the purchase of the motorbikes was conducted through the limited bidding process with the two known suppliers from 4th April 2020 to 6th April, 2020, because of the emergency nature associated with activity for which the purchase was made.


