Background

The Government of Liberia, through the Ministry of Agriculture, has received a support from the World Bank, for the Rural Economic Transformation Project (RETRAP). The RETRAP seeks to increase income of rural poor households through sustainable agricultural livelihood enhancements and improved rural access and agricultural marketing infrastructure services. As its focus, the project will support the value chains of cassava, Rubber, Poultry & Pig husbandry Vegetables. The project will be implemented in 11 of the 15 counties over a period of five years

Scope of Services

The Crop Development Specialist will be based in the Project's office in Monrovia with occasional travels to the project counties, and will contribute to the agenda of the **Rural Economic Transformation Project (RETRAP).** He/She will provide support in integrating and promoting agroecological interventions in ongoing projects and contribute to project/programme design efforts among others.

Main Responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the Operations Manager and in close collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture Gender, the Crop Development Specialist will perform the following functions:

- Provide support in integrating and promoting agro-ecological interventions in ongoing projects and contribute to project/programme design efforts
- Provide advice on what crops are most suited to the local context and the most resilient to climate change
- Identify and document suitable agronomic good practice options for enhanced climate resilience of farming practices
- Provides a framework for effective coordination, monitoring and review of project development activities, as well as programs of stakeholders in the sectors
- Ability to manage high workload, meet tight deadlines and multi-tasking under pressure
- Strong end-product focus and ability to deliver
- Decisive, problem-solver with strong analytical abilities
- Exceptional drive and entrepreneurship, a pronounced ability to motivate others and to build partnerships in different cultural context
