This grant will be used to finance activities of the Smallholder Agriculture Development for Food and Nutrition Security (SADFONS) Project. The project intends to apply part of the proceeds toward the Rehabilitation of an Agriculture Mechanization Center.

#### 5. All bids must be accompanied by the following listed below:

- V. Power of Attorney duly signed and stamped;
- VI. A bid security amount of 2% of the bid price express in absolute value and must be in the form of a Bank Guarantee;
- VII. Past performance history with at least three references including names, contacts and addresses;
- VIII. Copy of an audited financial statement for the last two/three years/Access to a line of credit;
  - IX. Submit copy of Association of Liberia Construction Contractor (ALCC) certificate and
  - X. A copy of the Ministry of Public Works classification certificate- Class (B10, 11 & 12).
