The Government of Liberia has received a loan from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to finance the Tree Crop Extension Project (TCE-II) The Government intends to apply part of the proceeds of the project for eligible payments under contract for Procurement of the Renovation of IFAD PIU Office.
