The Government of Liberia has received a loan from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to finance the Rural Community Finance Project (RCFP). The Government intends to apply part of the proceeds of the RCFP loan for eligible payments under contract for Procurement of **PROCUREMENT OF CCTVS CAMERAS AND INSTALLATION AT THE TWELVE RCFIs IN EIGHT COUNTIES**.

This invitation for bids (IFB) will appear in *Inprofile Daily* newspaper on *April 28, 2022*, and on the *Ministry of Agriculture website and the Executive Mansion website*.

1. The purchaser now invites sealed bids from eligible entities (bidders) for the provision of **Procurement of CCTVS Cameras and INSTALLATION AT THE TWELVE RCFIs, IFAD, PIU, Ministry of Agriculture Annex PMU, with in 28 days**. More details on these goods and related services are provided in the schedule of requirements in this bidding document.
2. This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to respond. Subject to restrictions noted in the bidding document, eligible entities may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the procurement.
3. The goods and related services, and the contract expected to be awarded, are divided into the following lots: Lot#1
4. Bidding will be conducted using the **national competitive bidding (NCB)** method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in this bidding document, in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook which is provided at www.ifad.org/project-procurement. The NCB process, as described, will include a review and verification of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the contract award.
5. Please note that a pre-bid conference [*will not*] be held as described in the bid data sheet (BDS), Section III of the bidding document.
6. Bidders interested in submitting a bid shall purchase the bidding document against payment of a non-refundable fee of [*NOT APPLICABLE*]. Bidding documents can be obtained by sending an e-mail or letter, giving full contact details of the bidder, to the following point of contact. This will ensure that the bidders receive updates regarding this bidding document.

Bids must be delivered to the address and in the manner specified in the bid data sheet – instructions to bidders 23.2, no later than TUESDAY, *May 24, 2022 at 1:00pm*.

7. Bidders shall be aware that late bids will not be accepted under any circumstance and will be returned unopened at the written request and cost of the bidder. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security or bid-securing declaration (as required) in the manner and amount specified in the bid data sheet.
8. Please note that electronic bids *shall not* be accepted.
