The Government of Liberia has received a loan from the World Bank toward the cost of the Smallholder Agriculture Transformation and Agribusiness Rehabilitation Project (STAR-P) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for Recruiting the Services of an Individual Consultant to Provide Environmental and Social Management Framework for the Smallholder Agriculture Transformation and Agribusiness Revitalization Project (STAR-P).
- 2. The scope of the assignment include but is not limited to:
 - Establishing clear procedures and methodologies for the environmental and social planning, review, approval and implementation of subprojects to be financed under the Project;
 - ii) Specify appropriate roles and responsibilities, and outline the necessary reporting procedures, for managing and monitoring environmental and social concerns related to subprojects
 - iii) Determine the training, capacity building and technical assistance needed to successfully implement the provisions of the ESMF;
 - iv) Establish the Project funding required to implement the ESMF requirements; and
 - v) Provide practical information resources for implementing the ESMF.
- 3. The Ministry of Agriculture now invites eligible Individual Consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Individual Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and at least five years relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate experience and qualification—The Consultant must have demonstrated experience in developing ESMF for Bankfinanced project either locally or internationally. Having experience in developing ESMF for a similar type of project will be an asset. The Consultant must have at least a Master's degree in Environmental Science, Natural Resource Management or in related fields with a minimum five years experience, or a Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Science, Natural Resource Management or related fields with at least 7 years experience. A local Consultant must be an EPA-certified Environmental Evaluator and an international must also be a Certified Environmental Evaluator of his/her country.
- 4. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 and revised July 1, 2014 ("Consultant
