Background

The Government of Liberia, through the Ministry of Agriculture, has received a support from the World Bank, for the Rural Economic Transformation Project (RETRAP). The RETRAP seeks to increase income of rural poor households through sustainable agricultural livelihood enhancements and improved rural access and agricultural marketing infrastructure services. As its focus, the project will support the value chains of cassava, Rubber, Poultry & Pig husbandry Vegetables. The project will be implemented in 11 of the 15 counties over a period of five years.

Scope of Services

The Senior Agricultural Services Advisor core function is to facilitate demand-driven technology generation to contribute to the transformation/commercialization of Liberia's agriculture, through close collaboration/cooperation with research institutions including CARI and Community Colleges for technology generation; National Standard Lab for standardization and certification; and linking research results to RETRAP crops and livestock development and agribusiness (SMEs) development.

The Ministry of Agriculture now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in performing the Services. Interested Individual Consultants should provide <u>updated Curriculum Vitae (CV) and relevant documents</u> indicating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The shortlisting criteria include the following:

Education: A Master's degree or its equivalence in agricultural economics, agriculture mechanization, agriculture technology, agriculture education/extension, agri-business administration, or closely related fields.

Working Experience:

A minimum of Ten (10) years of experience in applied technology generation and transfer. At least Ten (10) years of relevant experience in conducting research and results dissemination.

Proven experience and knowledge in Extension service delivery. Ability to manage high workload, meet tight deadlines and multitasking under pressure.

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Main Responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the National Program Coordinator (NPC) and in close collaboration with relevant MACs (MOA, MOCI, LACRA, RDF, CDA, NSL, CCs, FBO/CBOs, Farmers' Cooperatives, etc.), the Senior Agricultural Services Advisor is required to perform the following functions:
