The *Government of Liberia* through the Ministry of Agriculture *has received* financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Smallholder Agriculture Transformation and Agribusiness Revitalization Project (Star-P), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply and Delivery of Assorted Farming Tools, Protective Gears and Farming Equipment in three (3) lots.

Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (Procurement in Investment Project Financing Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services; July 2016) and revised November 2017, July 2018 and November 2020 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at 1400 hours.

All Bids must be accompanied by a *Bid Security*, of US\$2,000.00 (Two Thousand United States Dollars) for Lot 1 supply and delivery of farming tools; US\$1,600.00 (One Thousand Six Hundred United States Dollars) for Lot 2 supply and delivery of farming equipment and US\$2,500.00 (Two Thousand Five Hundred United States Dollars) for Lot 3 supply and delivery of protective gears or *for all three (3) lots* at US\$6,100.00 (Six Thousand One Hundred United States Dollars).
