The Government of Liberia through the Ministry of Agriculture has received additional credits in the amount of 30 million from the IDA Crisis Response Window – Early Response Financing CRW-ERF as additional financing (AF) to the Republic of Liberia for the Rural Economic Transformation Project (RETRAP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Procurement of Works: Construction of Five (5) Mechanization Service Centers (Bomi, Bong, Nimba, Lofa (Voinjama & Foyah)as below:

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's <u>Guidelines: Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (Procurement in</u> <u>Investment Project Financing – Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services; July 2016</u>) and revised November 2017, July 2018 and November 2020 and is open to all eligible Bidders as <u>defined in the Procurement Regulations</u> Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
