in the Procurement Regulations ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on 23rd April 2024 at 14:05 hours or 2:05pm Monrovia time.
- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security, of **US\$1,800.00** (**One Thousand Eight Hundred United States Dollars**) from a reputable bank.
